Which cheerleading squad is right for my cheerleader and our family?

The Cumberland Valley Youth Cheerleading Association offers a unique cheerleading program that allows any interested elementary or middle school student to be a cheerleader. We have a “no-cut” policy and offer different levels of participation depending on age, level of interest, and experience. All participants are assigned to a squad. In an effort to help you make an informed decision regarding the “best team fit” for your child and your family, please examine the team profiles below.

CVYCA cheerleading evaluations will be held the last week in May for cheerleaders going into grades 2 through 8 and returning minis. Participants will learn a cheer, a chant, a dance, jumps, and demonstrate tumbling skills. Cheerleaders will be placed on teams **based on individual ability and level of interest**. During the cheerleading registration process in March/April, parents will have the opportunity to submit a cheerleading interest form indicating permission for your child to be evaluated for specific teams. The team level you select for your child will indicate that you understand the responsibilities and commitment required for your child’s participation at that level. Students enrolled in kindergarten and 1st grade at the time of registration are automatically placed on instructional level teams and do not participate in evaluations. (*Exceptions are made for young advanced tumblers or returning minis who may choose to try out for a Pee Wee level team.*)

During the month of August, when children are looking for something to do, all teams will practice Tuesday through Thursday from 6 PM to 8 PM at Eagle View Middle School. We highly recommend carpooling for all participants. This will make cheerleading more enjoyable for you and your child. *Instructional cheerleaders wear a white, inexpensive leatherette sneaker that they purchase on their own during the summer months or they may purchase the select cheerleading sneaker.

Due to the normal wear of uniform items, I understand that I must purchase the appropriate clothing items for the team my child is assigned. I further understand the responsibilities and commitment required for our child's participation in the CVYCA program and the team she is assigned. Although CVYCA has a no-cut policy and all children are placed on a team, my **child's ability is a key factor in team placement** (for children in 2nd through 8th grade).

Cheerleaders may be asked to temporarily assist another team or permanently join a different team if openings become available due to illness, injury, or resignation. These situations may happen during any part of the season but typically are handled during the summer months before competitions begin or after competitions conclude for the white teams. We ask that all cheerleaders and parents be supportive of these changes.

CVYCA CHEERLEADING

Conditions for Participation

Being a CVYCA cheerleader requires significant commitment, but brings with it endless rewards. As the saying goes "practice makes perfect" so it stands to reason that attending all practices is the first step toward a successful season. In cheerleading, each participant has a part in their team's competition routine that is unique and can only be performed by one specific individual. There is no second string or "bench" for a CVYCA cheerleading team. In order for a team to practice and compete, all participants must be present.

That being said, the following conditions must be adhered to by all pee wee, pony, and junior cheerleading families:

1. VACATIONS

Vacations must be scheduled during the off-season so as not to interfere with practices and competition weekends. Please plan all summer vacations prior to the start of the season on August 3. Please keep the weekend before Thanksgiving available and for Red teams - keep Presidents' Day weekend available.

Please keep the following weekends clear for competitions:

White teams: Oct 22-23; 29-30; Nov 5-6; 12-13; 19-20; Dec 3-4; 10-11

Red teams: Same as above plus Jan 7-8; 14-15; 21-22; 28-29; Feb 4-5; 11-12; 18-19; 25-26;
Mar 4-5; 11-12; 18-19

2. PRACTICES

Cheerleading is the ultimate team sport so all cheerleaders need to be present at each and every practice in order to practice as a team. When necessary, cheerleaders must be willing to make personal sacrifices in order to attend ALL practices so they may work together to achieve their goals. The August practice schedule on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays allows for 4-day weekend "get-aways" to the beach and to visit relatives. **Attendance at all practices is mandatory.**

3. BASKETBALL GAMES

CVYBA basketball games are played primarily in January and February. **In order to compete in the rec league divisions at cheerleading competitions, CVYCA cheerleaders must cheer for a recreational sport for an entire season.** In order to fulfill our obligation as a rec cheerleading program, all basketball games are mandatory. In an attempt to be fair and equitable, cheerleaders who miss a game for any reason (sickness, wedding, schedule conflict, etc.) are required to make up the game to obtain credit. Attendance records will be kept by the advisors. The CVYBA basketball game schedule will not be available until after Thanksgiving.

4. NOTIFICATION

It is the responsibility of the parents to notify the advisors in advance if a cheerleader is going to miss a practice, game, or cheerleading event. Unexcused absences from practices include late arrivals and/or leaving early in addition to missing entire practices. Note: A tumbling session is not a valid reason for arriving late, leaving early, or missing practice. Unexcused absences from practices, games, or competitions may result in a positional change for the team member to help alleviate problems associated with the absences. Absences may affect team placement (red or white) in future years as the commitment for participation increases. Please keep in mind, school functions and religious functions are deemed excusable absences.

It will be a busy cheerleading season. Commitment to all aspects of the program (fundraising, practices, tumbling classes, cheerleading camp, community service events, competitions, games, uniform care, and transportation to and from all activities) is needed from the parents as well as the cheerleaders. As a cheerleading parent, I am signing this document to indicate that I am willing to abide by the conditions for participation for my child for the 2011-2012 CVYCA cheerleading season.
